

## Literature Search: Prehospital EMS - 1987 through June 1988

In June of 1988, the *Journal* conducted a literature search on the Medline® data base via PaperChase® on the CompuServe Information Service®. The search was made using the search word of "prehospital" which brought up the prompt in Figure 1. From that prompt, the keyword prehospital, with 332 citations, and the medical subject heading of prehospital emergency care, with 4288 citations, was selected. This composite is represented by list A in Figure 2. Next, a search was made to find all citations from 1987 to date. To get all citations up to the most current, search limits of 1987 through 1989 were used, as represented by

list B in Figure 1. Finally, a search was made for all citations found in both list A and B, resulting in 301 citations as represented by list C. The contents of list C are presented in this literature search. In the interests of space, just the title and journal information are shown. This will be sufficient to locate or request reprints. Some citations found to be irrelevant to emergency care were excluded from this listing. These citations are shown with their search number followed by the word "excluded." Those titles found in brackets were published in non-English languages.
